

*Maps.lycos.com* allows you to locate any street address in the United States on a map that you can zoom in and out on. You can also find driving instructions from any two places in the United States.


**What should I do?**

1. Let's say we have the address: 4603 Warsaw Avenue  
Lyons, Illinois, USA

Go to [www.mapquest.com](http://www.mapquest.com) and on the home page, fill in this address, exactly as here on your right. Then press "get map."



**This is the map you should get:**



Do you see the red star? That is the location of the address, 4603 Warsaw Avenue, Lyons, IL. At the right side of the map you will see **ZOOM IN / ZOOM OUT**. Zoom in means the map is bigger, with more detail; zoom out means the map gets smaller, with less detail. **This feature is important. It allows you to answer questions 4 and 5 below.** It allows you to see where the city is located within the state. For example, you'll find that Lyons is a Chicago suburb on the west side, and if you zoom out some more, you'll see that Chicago is in the northeastern area of Illinois.

In the case of Warsaw Avenue in Lyons, zoom out two notches below. Do you see Chicago next to the water? Now you can see the Lyons in the center of the map? It shows you that Lyons is one of the many Chicago suburbs.

You'll also see that the nearest major highway is 55. Zoom in twice (2X) and you can see some detail about how to get to 4603 Warsaw Avenue by car from highway 55.

2. All right--you know how to do questions 3, 4 and 5

6. Go back to home page. You are now going to “Get Driving Directions” by typing in your **starting point** and your destination (**ending point**). The ending point is the address your teacher circled for you before. The starting point is the same for everybody: 1500 Market Street, Philadelphia, PA:

Press Get Directions. On the next page you’ll see a map showing the roads between Philadelphia and your destination, with a list of directions

- 1 . Begin at 200 Market St on S 2nd St and go South for 300 feet      0.1 mi
- 2 . Turn right on Trotter Aly and go West for 150 feet                      0.0 mi
- 3 . Turn right on S Strawberry St and go North for 400 feet                0.1 m
- ...and so on (there is a list of 15 instructions).
